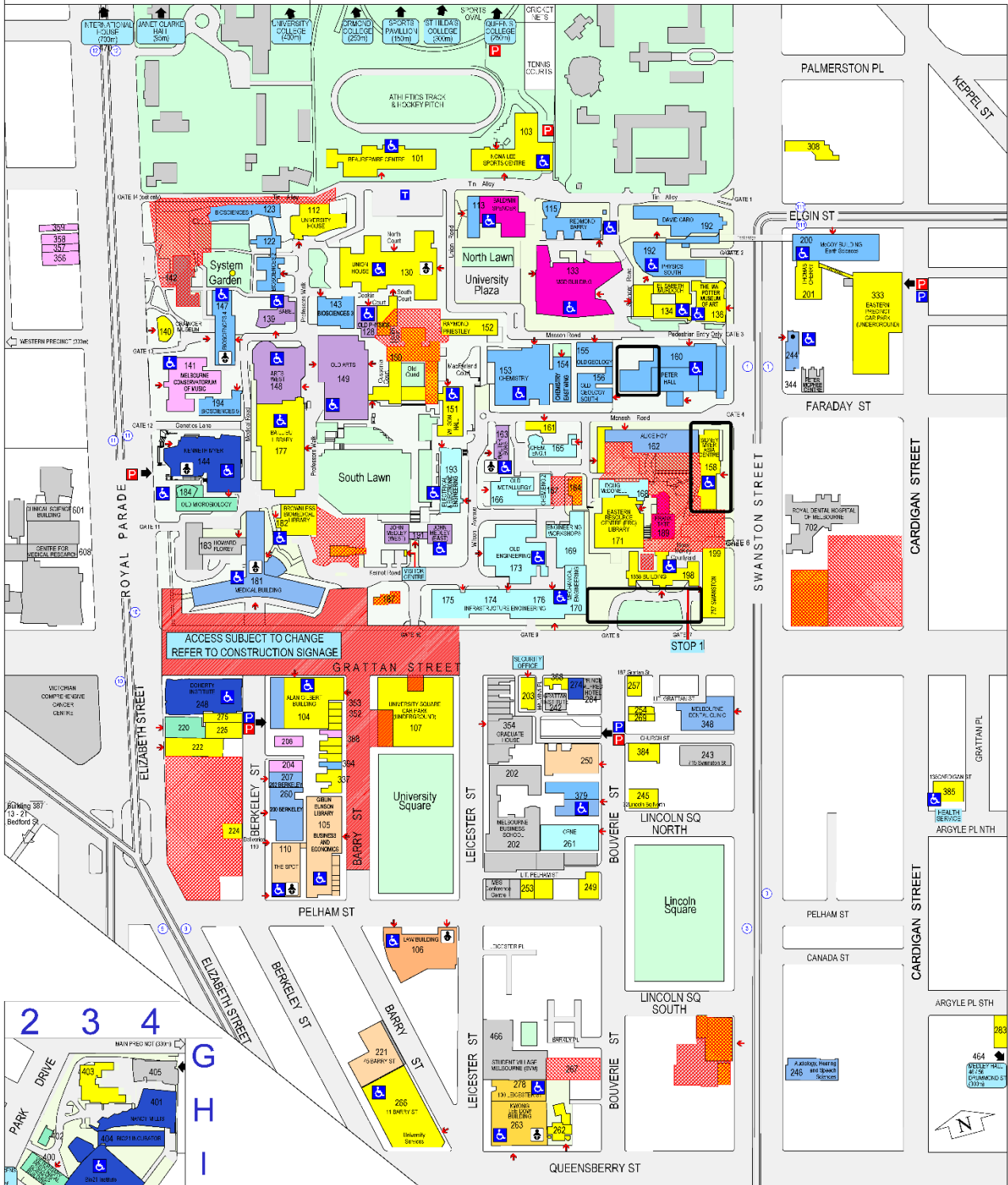
ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUBJECT ENROLMENT
